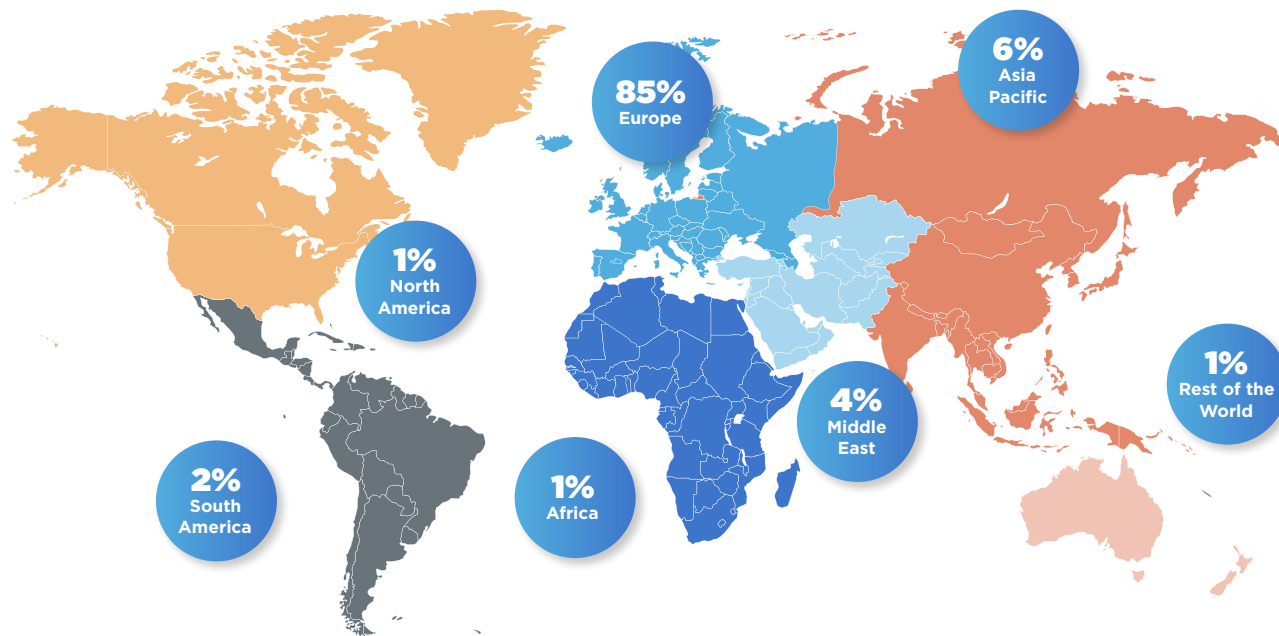

Seville's 180 km of ITS-optimised bike lanes further illustrate its commitment to sustainable transport, creating safe, accessible, and efficient cycling networks used by thousands daily. Complementing this is the SEVici shared bicycle system, offering an affordable and eco-friendly alternative to car travel while promoting an active lifestyle for both residents and visitors.

Additionally, Seville is showcasing cutting-edge mobility solutions like the MathIT.MOTUS app, which leverages real-time ITS data to optimise traffic flow and public transport efficiency in the PCT Cartuja district. These innovations underscore Seville's role as a model for smart urban planning and ITS application. With its forward-thinking projects and dedication to sustainability, Seville is an ideal venue for the 2025 ITS European Congress, where 3,500+ participants from public and private sectors will converge to explore the next generation of transport systems.
